Question: What is cribbing?
Answer:

A: Cribbing is a bad habit that involves a horse biting down on a fence, railing, or any solid surface with its teeth and sucking in air quickly. This causes a shot of endorphins to release in the brain. Horses become addicted. Cribbing causes medical issues, including wearing down their teeth/gums and weight loss. Horses become preoccupied with cribbing; they ignore their food and stop eating.
